Fri 18th Cloudy rainy weather wind from the Northward steering E & S at 12 double reefed the topsails at 6 split the foresail took it in and close reefed the topsails & so observed

Sun 20th of March Cloudy weather first part wind from the Westward steering E by S at 11 AM wind veered round to the ESE steering by the wind with Stacks aboard at 4 PM double reefed the topsails at 6 furler the mainsail
Lat by Chron 36° 01' S Long by Chron 125° 45' West

Mon 21st Cloudy weather first part wind from the ESE steering by the wind heading SE at 11 AM tacked to the Southward latter part heading SE by S
Lat 35° 25' S Long by Chron 124° 06' West

Tues 22nd Cloudy weather strong breeze from the SE steering by the wind with Stacks aboard under double reefed topsails at 4 PM close reefed them and reefed the mainsail
Lat 36° 09' S Long by Chron 125° 00'

Wed 23rd Fine weather wind from the SE steering by the wind with Stacks aboard at 4 PM were ship heading S by E close reefed topsails
Lat 34° 28' S Long by Chron 126° 51' W

Thurs 24th Fine weather strong gales from ESE heading E & E at sun down were ship heading S wind blowing to the Eastward
Lat 34° 48' S Long by Chron 122° 48' W

Fri 25th Fine weather strong gales from the ESE heading SE close reefed topsails and reefed courses
Lat 36° 22' S Long by Chron 122° 48' W

Sat 26th Cloudy rainy weather with strong gales from ESE lying by the wind heading S at 4 PM took in the fore and main topsails were round heading ESE & so observed
