Thurs 7th Fine weather winds from E.S. & S steering E.S.E. with all sail set Lat 41 18 S Long by thro 111 41 W

Fri 8th Fine weather winds from the N & W steering E.S.E. Lat 42 37 S Long by thro 110 41 W

Sat 9th Fine weather strong gales from N.S.W. steering S.E. latter part steering S.E. & E Lat 43 48 S Long by thro 107 28 W

Sund 10th Clear weather strong gales from N.S.W. steering S.E. by E Lat 45 25 S Long 104 05 W

Mon 11th Fine weather first part variable from the N middle and latter part E.S.E. steering E.S.E. Lat 47 00 S Long 101 41 W

Tues 12th First part fine weather strong gales from the N being too under a close reefed main topsail at 4 P.M. kept the off S.E. by E set the fore and mizen topsail middle and latter part moderate winds from the N.E. & E.S. Lat 48 20 S Long by thro 98 00 W
