Fri 15th First and middle part strong gales from the W with heavy squalls of hail steering ESE latter part moderate winds from SW by W steering E by S

Sat 16th Fine weather light winds from the Westward steering E by S
Lat 54 40 S Long 86 30 W

Sund 17th first part cloudy weather winds from the S steering E by S middle and latter part strong gales from the NNE steering E by S
Lat by Dr 56 20 S Long by 90 53 26 W

Mon 18 first part fine weather strong breeze from NW steering S middle part strong gales from the S at 1 PM hove her to at 4 PM kept her off again steering E by S latter part moderate wind NW

Wens 20th of April first part clear weather strong breeze from NW steering ESE by S at daylight saw an American ship standing to the SW middle part light winds at 2 PM passed another ship standing to the W latter part light winds from the S

Thurs 21st first thick foggy weather winds from the S steering by the wind middle and latter part winds from the W steering S by S
Lat 58 24 S Long by Chro 160 41 W

Fri 22nd Cloudy weather light winds from the NW steering by the wind heading SE latter part a breeze from the NW steering S by S
Lat 59 15 S Long by Chro 164 01 W

Sat 23rd first and middle part fine weather winds from NW steering S latter part rainy steering S by S
Lat 56 34 S Long by Chro 61 03 W

Sund 24th fine weather light winds from NW steering SSE at 10 AM saw a sail astern coming up with us at 1 PM spoke her was an English bark from Hobart town bound to London with a cargo of wool, keeping us company to get some tobacco
Lat 55 50 South Long by Chro 58 30 W

Mon 25th fine weather strong breeze from the W steering S at 8 AM spoke the bark he kept us company all day waiting for tobacco
Lat 53 24 S Long by Chro 55 20 W
