

178 Ship Gideon Howland from the Society

Fri 20th May first part strong breeze from the SE with heavy squalls of wind and rain much and latter part the same steering 88°
Lat 9° 39' S Long by thro 83° 05' W

Sat 21st Fine weather strong trades steering 88° by E saw an English brig steering 88° by E
Lat 7° 19' S Long by thro

Sun 22nd Fine weather light trades steering 88° by W at daylight saw a sail at 2 PM spoke the Galen of Warren from the Society Islands bound to Warren with 1700 bls of oil
Lat 4° 44' S Long by thro 34° 40' W

Mon 23rd Fine weather light trades steering 88° by W the Galen in company m^{rs} Coffin a passenger left her to take passage in this ship Lat by Dr reckning 2° 42' S

Tues 24th light winds and variables with innumerable squalls of rain course 88° by W the Galen in sight got no observ^e

Weds 25th Fine weather light winds from the 88° steering by the wind the Galen in sight Lat 42 miles S Long by thro 37° 32' W

Thurs 26th Fine weather light air from the Eastward working to the Southward the Galen in sight the watch employed doing nothing
Lat 14 miles S Long by thro 38° 05' W

179 Islands towards 88° by E at Baker's Bay 1840

Fri 27th of May fine weather and calm the watch employed in ordinary duty the Galen in sight
Lat 14° 18' S Long by thro 60° 10' W

Sat 28th light and variable winds with plenty of rain the Galen in company 88° by E

Sun 29th Fine weather and calm the Galen in sight about 6 miles to the SE
Lat 49° 18' S Long by thro 38° 16' W

Mon 30th the first and much part squally weather light winds from the 88° at daylight saw a sail on the weather bow steering 88° by E latter part strong breeze with heavy squalls of wind and rain steering 88° by W the Galen in company
Lat 1° 24' S Long by thro 68° 10' W

Tues 31st Fine weather strong trades steering 88° by W the Galen abt the lee beam an other ship in sight off the lee quarter
Lat 3° 13' S Long by thro

Weds 1st of June Fine weather strong trades steering 88° by E the Galen in sight from the mast head off the lee beam
Lat 4° 59' S Long by thro 110

Thurs 2nd clear weather strong trades steering 88° by E the Galen off the lee beam the watch employed turning down rig
Lat 5° 46' S Long by thro 118
