Monday July 4th 1864

These 24 hours commences

With light variable winds & calm foggy at times
 Steering N.E. James Thompson of duty Pick A
 Number of icebergs in sight. Middle part calm
 later part light breeze from S. & rising Steering
 E. the watch employed in doing Schr duty so ends
 No Obs

Tuesday July 5th

Commences

with A brisk breeze from S. & rising weather
 Steering S.E. passed A Number of icebergs
 at 6 p.m. Double reefed the foresail & mainsail
 Middle part strong breeze & rain later part
 moderate & thick fog made sail. James Thompson
 on duty again so ends this day Long 47.37 W.

Wednesday July 6th

Commences with

A brisk breeze from N.W. & foggy weather
 Steering S.E. by N. the watch employed fixing
 cutting gear at 6 p.m. took in Mainsail &
 fore topsail Middle part strong breeze later part
 moderate & foggy the watch employed at various jobs
 Lat 52.34

Thursday July 7th

Commences with

A moderate breeze from N. & foggy weather by the wind
 up at 6. by 6. under easy sail Middle part A light
 gale reefed the foresails A large swell on
 later part more moderate so ends this day
 Lat 54.07 S

 by the wind up at 6. by 6. under easy sail A few Pick ones
 Middle part calm & fog later part light breeze from S. &
 rain the watch variously employed so ends this day No Obs

Saturday July 9th

Commences with

Moderate breeze from S.E. & rising weather Steering
 N.W. & under easy sail the Pick getting better Middle
 part wind hauled to S.E. & increased Steering S.
 Later part A gale from S. took in foresail & jib
 & reefed the foresail so ends these 24 hours

Sunday July 10th

Commences

with A moderate gale from S.E. & rain laging to
 under Double reefed foresail & foretopmast staydail up
 N.W. & Middle part moderate later part S. the Mainsail
 Double reefed & jib by the wind heading S.W. & James
 Thoms off duty Pick with vessel so ends this day No Obs

Monday July 11th

This day commences

in with A moderate breeze from S. & variable weather
 Steering S. under easy sail A large swell Middle part
 calm & pleasant later part light breeze from S. Steering
 S. the watch variously employed the inner topmast parted
 down together again & set it up so ends these 24 hours
 Lat by Obs 57.35 N

Tuesday July 12th

Commences

with A moderate breeze from S. & cloudy weather Steering
 N.W. James Thoms still off duty Pick Middle part
 light breeze later part the same the watch variously
 employed so ends this day
