

Schr Glacier Log. Laying in Winter quarters at
Sunday October 16th 1864

Commenced with
light light air from the N.W. & variable weather. Middle 21
Later part calm thermometer at 22 so ends this day
Monday Oct 17th

Commenced with
light variable winds & thick hazy weather. Middle 21 later
part much the same thermometer at 23. so ends this day
Tuesday Oct 18th

This day comes
in with a strong breeze from the S.E. & cloudy weather
Middle 21 later part the same thermometer at 22.
Wednesday Oct 19th

Commenced with
a brisk breeze from the S.W. & cloudy weather took
off five casks of water at 7 p.m. wind howled so
S.W. increased to a gale let go the larboard
Anchor thermometer at 23 so ends this day
Thursday Oct 20th

Commenced
with a strong breeze from the N.W. & pleasant
weather hove up the larboard Anchor later part
moderate thermometer from 10 to 4 degrees above zero
Friday Oct 21st

This day comes
in with a strong breeze from the N.W. & snow
melts from the water the thermometer at 4 zero Mid
part the same later part two degrees below zero
Saturday Oct 22nd

Commenced
with a strong breeze from the N.W. & cloudy
weather Middle 21 later part the same
the thermometer at zero so ends this day

Murble Island Remarks on Board
Sunday October 23rd 1864

Commenced with
a light breeze from the N.W. & pleasant weather the harbor
froze over at 3 p.m. hove up the larboard Anchor Middle
21 later part pleasant thermometer one degree above zero
Monday Oct 24th

These 24 hours
commenced with light variable winds & pleasant weather
thermometer 4 degrees above zero men on the ice going
from one vessel to the other later part thermometer
two degrees below zero so ends this day
Tuesday Oct 25th

Commenced
with light breeze from the N.E. & light snow all
hands ashore cutting ice for water Middle part
light the same later part gentle hauled to S.E.
thermometer 14 degrees above zero
Wednesday Oct 26th

Commenced
with a brisk breeze from S.E. & cloudy weather
Middle 21 later part the same thermometer 14
degrees above zero
Thursday Oct 27th

Commenced
with a brisk breeze from the S.E. & cloudy weather
all hands ashore cutting ice at 12 p.m. finished
later part fresh breeze thermometer at 22 above zero
Friday Oct 28th

Commenced
with light breeze from S.E. & stormy weather a few
men ashore gunning Middle 21 later part the same
thermometer 23 degrees above zero so ends this day
Saturday Oct 29th

Commenced with
a light breeze from the S.E. & pleasant weather all hands
cutting ice No more the vessel at 12 p.m. finished
all ready for winter thermometer at 21 so ends
