

Schr Glacier Log. Now Laying in
Wednesday January 18th 1865
Commences with light
breezes from the N. W. pleasant weather. A party
gone across to the main land to look for natives
Middle of Later part pleasant Thermometer 14
degrees below zero

Thursday Jan 19th
Commences with
light breezes from the N. W. pleasant weather. Middle
part the same at about 6 o'clock A. M. four men from
forward went across to the main land. At about
6 o'clock P. M. three of them came aboard about but not
one by the name of Lewis Greenbridge got lost to
the island. I lost sight of him. A party went out in
search with lights till 10 o'clock P. M. supposed he had
departed was frozen as we see no sign of him. at 7 A. M.
Thermometer 10 degrees below zero at 10 P. M. 18 below
Happily to go from the captain on Friday Jan 20th
Commences with

light air from N. W. pleasant weather at daylight
men out from all the vessels looking for the man
at 9 A. M. found him alive with one foot & fingers
frozen brought him aboard & dressed him. at 11.30
the party arrived from the main land see no
natives Later part pleasant. man doing well
Thermometer 20 degrees below zero

Saturday Jan 21st
This day comes in
with light breezes from N. W. pleasant
weather. Middle part got off a load of ice
Later part pleasant sick man doing
well Thermometer 22 degrees below zero

Winter quarters at Marble Island
Sunday January 22nd 1865
Commences with
light breezes from the N. W. pleasant weather. Middle
of Later part much the same sick man doing well
Thermometer 22 degrees below zero ends this day

Monday Jan 23rd
This day comes in
with light breezes from the N. W. thick weather. Middle part
the same two natives come to the vessel. & three captured
from Cape Island. A party gone to the main
land hunting Later part strong breeze & thick
Thermometer 11 degrees below zero

Tuesday Jan 24th
Commences with
strong breezes from N. W. snow frost. Middle & later
part much the same. A dance aboard the vessel
gives Thermometer 20 degrees below zero

Wednesday Jan 25th
These 24 hours come
in with a moderate gale from the N. variable weather
Middle part much the same Later part thick
with snow frost part of the men ashore at Centre
Thermometer 11 degrees below zero

Thursday Jan 26th
Commences with
brisk breezes from the N. W. pleasant weather. Middle &
Later part much the same. party sighted from the main
land see a few deer & got none. Thermometer 4 degrees
below zero the sick man doing well

Friday Jan 27th
This day comes in
with light breezes from the N. W. pleasant
weather. A dance aboard the vessel gives Thermometer
10 degrees below zero Middle & later part pleasant
