weather middle part snow & light breeze later part
light breeze from the N.W. cloudy thermometer 2 degrees
below zero so ends this day

Saturday Feb 25th
Commenced
with A brisk breeze from the N.W. & variable weather
middle part A gale Later part moderate
thermometer 35 degrees below zero, sick man
doing well

Sunday Feb 26th
These 24 hours
Commenced with A moderate breeze from N.W.
& hazy weather middle part wind variable later
part light breeze from N.W. thermometer 34 degrees
below zero

Monday Feb 27th
Commenced with
light breeze from N.W. & hazy weather middle part
pleasant later part snow frost & brisk breeze Ther
44 degrees below zero

Tuesday Feb 28th
A brisk breeze
from N.W. thick weather with snow frost middle part
the same later part light breeze the sick man
getting better thermometer 38 degrees below zero

A Marble Island Hudson Bay
Wednesday March 1st 1865
This day comes in
with A light breeze from N.W. & snow frost middle
part much the same later part pleasant thermometer
32 degrees below zero

Thursday March 2nd
Commenced with
light breeze from N.W. & pleasant weather middle part
the same later part light breeze from N.W. & pleasant
got aboard A load of ice Ther 34 degrees below zero

Friday March 3rd
This day comes
in with light breeze from N.E. & pleasant weather
middle part the same later part pleasant thermometer
34 degrees below zero

Saturday March 4th
Commenced with
light breeze from N.W. & pleasant weather middle part
the same later part brisk breeze from N.E. & pleasant
thermometer 37 degrees below zero

Sunday March 5th
This day comes in
with A brisk breeze from N.E. & pleasant weather middle
part A gale part the men ashore to the theater the
last one of the ship later part A brisk gale &
& snow frost thermometer 28 degrees below zero

Monday March 6th
Commenced with
A brisk gale from N.E. with snow frost blowing mild
part the same later part moderate thermometer
30 degrees below zero

Tuesday March 7th
Commenced
with light breeze from N.W. & pleasant weather
middle part much the same later part the
same thermometer 38 degrees below zero
