

Bohr Glacier Log in Belinder

Wednesday March 8th 1845

Commenced with light breeze from N. pleasant weather & few natives arrived with a few deer skins. Middle part pleasant. Later part the same. Thermometer 42 degrees below zero.

Thursday March 9th

This day comes in with light breeze from S.E. pleasant weather got off a load of ice. Middle part pleasant. Later part the same. Thermometer 32 degrees below zero.

Friday March 10th

These 24 hours commenced with light breeze from N.W. pleasant weather. Natives left for home again. Middle part a dance about the Angel Gibbs. The sick man the same. Later part light breeze from N.W. Thermometer 13 degrees below zero.

Saturday March 11th

Commenced with moderate breeze from N. pleasant weather. Middle & later part a heavy gale & thick. Thermometer 12 degrees below zero.

Sunday March 12th

A heavy gale from N.W. thick. Middle & later part the same. Thermometer 32 degrees below zero.

Monday March 13th

Commenced with a gale from S.W. thick. Lewis & Clark the same. Middle & later part moderate & thick. Ther 28 degrees below zero so early this day.

quarters at Marble Island

Tuesday March 14th

Commenced with weather thick & brisk breeze from N.W. Middle part the same. A dance about the Angel Gibbs. Later part light breeze & pleasant. Thermometer 34 degrees below zero.

Wednesday March 15th

This day comes in with light breeze from N.W. pleasant weather. Two sleds & natives arrived with about 1000 pounds of deer meat & a few skins. Middle part pleasant. Later part light breeze from S.W. & cloudy. Thermometer 25 degrees below zero.

Thursday March 16th

Commenced with light breeze from N.W. & cloudy weather got off a load of ice got 140 pounds of deer meat. Middle part snow. Later part brisk breeze from S.E. & snow. Natives left again for more meat. Three officers went. Thermometer 4 degrees below zero.

Friday March 17th

Commenced with snow & brisk breeze from S.E. Middle part cloudy. A dance. The sick man the Angel Gibbs. Later part cloudy & light breeze from N.W. Thermometer 4 degrees below zero.

Saturday March 18th

Commenced with light breeze from N. pleasant weather. Middle part a strong breeze with snow. Later part a gale got off some plank from the theatre for sleds. Thermometer at zero.

Sunday March 19th

A gale from N. & cloudy weather. Middle part moderate & pleasant. Later part light breeze & pleasant. Thermometer 4 degrees below zero.
