

Schooner Glacier Log. Wintering

Tuesday April 25th 1865

This day comes in with brisk breeze from S.E. & cloudy weather. Middle part wind hauled to N.W. & cleared off later part light breeze from Westward & pleasant. The sailing men are all well. Employed fixing boats & other jobs. Thermometer 11 degrees above zero.

Wednesday April 26th

commences with light breeze from N.W. & changing weather. Middle part much the same. Later part a gale from E. with snow. Thermometer 18 degrees above zero.

Thursday April 27th

The first part a gale from E. with snow. Middle part the same. Later part strong breeze from S.E. Sent out some men to look for the boat on the floe. The ice breaking off see nothing of the boat. supposed had got above with the ice. Thermometer 19 above.

Friday April 28th

comes in with strong breeze from S.E. with snow sent out some more men to see if they could find the boat & caught one sled. The bark Inlet gave lost one boat at same time see no signs of them. The ice broke off on shore of them. Middle part cloudy & light breeze from S. Later part light breeze from S.W. with snow. Thermometer 11 degrees above zero.

Saturday April 29th

commences with light breeze from the westward & snow. Middle part cloudy & brisk breeze. Later part pleasant & light breeze from N.E. A party out on the floe looking for the boat & a number of them. lost 1411 set of bars saw one of one lance saw brassails one sled & about 50 fathoms of line. Then at zero.

At Marble Island Harbor

Monday April 30th 1865

commences with a brisk breeze from N.E. & changing weather. Middle part much the same. Later part fresh breeze & snow. Then at zero.

Tuesday April May 1st 1865

This day comes in with a heavy fall of snow & brisk breeze from N.E. Middle part much the same. Later part light breeze with snow got off spur & soil from offshore. The carpenter employed making a sled. Thermometer 10 above.

Wednesday May 2nd

comes in with light breeze from N.E. & snow. Middle part much the same. Later part snow & light breeze. Thermometer 10 degrees above zero.

Thursday May 3rd

commences with light breeze from N.W. with snow got off some empty casks from the theatre. Middle part pleasant. Later the same. Thermometer at zero.

Friday May 4th

This day comes in with fine weather & light breeze from N.W. Two families of Natives arrived brought some deer meat & a few skins. Middle part pleasant. Later part light breeze from S.E. with light fall of snow getting ready for floe whaling. Thermometer 10 above zero.

Saturday May 5th

These 24 hours commences with cloudy weather & moderate breeze from S.E. Middle part & later light breeze from N. with snow got off a load of ice. Thermometer 22 degrees above zero.
