

Schooner Glacier Log. Wintering
Saturday May 6th 1865

Commenced with pleasant weather & brisk breeze from N.W. Middle part light breeze & fair weather. Later part a heavy Gale from N.E. accompanied with snow. Ther at here
Sunday May 7th

This day comes in with a heavy gale from N.E. attended with snow. Middle part the same. Later part wind hauled to N.W. & blowing a gale. Thermometer 6 degrees below zero.

Monday May 8th
Commenced with a strong gale from the N.W. with some drifting. Middle part brisk breeze. Later part the same. Took a cask of seal & bread to the N.E. end of the island on a sled. The natives all left for the main land. Thermometer 4 below zero.

Tuesday May 9th
This day comes in with brisk breeze from N.W. & pleasant weather all hands to N.E. end at 6 1/2 o'clock. A gun returned about boat out hard slating. Middle part pleasant. Later part brisk breeze & cloudy getting ready things to take to N.E. end. Ther at here.

Wednesday May 10th
Commenced with brisk breeze from N.W. & changeable weather with snow squalls. Middle part fresh gale & cloudy. Missionary Cross, and Richard Long, gave William Paul a very severe beating. Paul not able to do his duty in consequence of the beating. Four men snow blind & going better. Later part cloudy & light breeze sent ~~fire~~ ^{boat} to the N.E. end with provisions for fox whaling. Ther at here.

St. Marble Island Harbor
Thursday May 11th 1865

This day comes in with cloudy weather & moderate breeze from N.W. at 4 p.m. arrived about. Left the boat part way down the island on account of young ice had to haul them on the floor. She pushed off about 4 miles from the shore ice. Middle part pleasant. Later part light breeze from N.W. & toward took a boat to the passage. Young ice could not get out. employed getting things ready for the N.E. end. Lewis Throbridge still off duty with his frozen foot it is getting better. William Paul quite sick today. Thermometer 10 above zero so ends this day.

Friday May 12th
The first part brisk breeze from N.W. & fair weather. Middle part cloudy. Later part the same with a light fall of snow. Thermometer 6 above zero.

Saturday May 13th
This day comes in with cloudy weather & fresh gale from N.W. Middle part the same. Later part moderate. Lewis Throbridge able to walk some. W. Paul off duty from the effect of the beating. Get of the snow blind is all well again. Ther 10 degrees above zero.

Sunday May 14th
Commenced with brisk breeze from N.W. & cloudy weather. Middle part a fresh gale & pleasant. Later part the same got the boats up. Clear water along shore to the N.E. end. Thermometer 10 above zero.

Monday May 15th
This day comes in with pleasant weather & fresh gale from N.W. Four parties arrived from the plain land with about 100 lbs of deer meat & few skins. Middle part moderate. Later part sent three boats to N.E. end & put up a house & left one boat. Ther at here.
