

Schooner Glacier Log. Wintering

Wednesday May 16th 1865

Commenced with strong breeze from N.W. pleasant weather. W. Paul off duty sick yet. Middle part fresh gale. Later part the same. Three boat crews from the Lake arrived and went down to the N.E. to live & look out for whales. Thermometer 10 above zero.

Thursday May 17th

This day comes in with a fresh gale from N.W. changeable weather giving ready to live on the N.E. end of the island. Later part moved three boat crews to N.E. end to whale it so ends.

Friday May 18th

Light breeze from N.W. pleasant weather. Later part a fresh gale from S.E. with snow so ends.

Saturday May 19th

A fresh gale from S.E. attended with snow. Middle part moderate later brisk breeze from N.W. cloudy weather.

Sunday May 20th

A brisk breeze from the N.W. pleasant weather. The pack four miles off the south side & in on the north side of the island. Middle part later part pleasant.

Monday May 21st

Commenced with light breeze from the N.W. pleasant weather. The pack in middle part the same later part clear water along shore. Two boat went to the ship for stores so ends.

at Marble Island Harbor

Tuesday May 22nd 1865

Light breeze from the N.W. cloudy weather very little clear water to be seen. Middle part later part pleasant.

Wednesday May 23rd

Light breeze from the N.W. pleasant weather. Clear water along shore on the south side. Lewis growth bridge & W. Paul on duty & living on the island all the evening. Noaked & Whaling. Middle part later part pleasant.

Thursday May 24th

Commenced with fresh breeze from the N.W. pleasant weather. Middle part later part light breeze & pleasant.

Friday May 25th

This day comes in with light variable winds & changeable weather. The pack in shore. Middle part later cloudy.

Saturday May 26th

Commenced with light breeze from N.E. & changeable weather. Middle part raining later part thick fog. The pack in.

Sunday May 27th

This day comes in with light breeze from N.E. & foggy & rather at 2 p.m. seen whales off the N.E. end close in shore. The first whales the season all the boats out & a strip of water along shore at 5 P.M. seen three whales in the ice to the N. of the boat so the vessel went looking for whales so none. Light breeze from N.W. & pleasant so ends.
