

Schooner Glacier Log. Cruising

Friday August 4th 1865

Commenced with a moderate gale from N.W. & cloudy weather cruising off North Island & sails in sight. Single reefed fore & mainsail. Middle part hauled the same as the first. Later part moderate & pleasant at 11 A.M. came to anchor off the S. side & got the raft & there for water so ends

Saturday Aug 5

This day comes in with light breeze from N.W. & pleasant weather at 6 p.m. got the raft aboard & got under weigh & raised. A whale in shore & lowered three boats for him at 10 p.m. came aboard without success & started off shore quick. Later part fresh breeze from S.W. two boats ashore for water & one boat in looking for whales so ends this day

Sunday Aug 6

Commenced with a strong breeze from S.W. & changing weather. Working to the S. all the boats aboard employed. Working water. Middle part brisk breeze. Later part light variable winds & cloudy weather. Spoke Bark Argy Haft 6 sails in sight so ends this day

Monday August 7th

These 24 hours commenced with strong breeze from S.W. & cloudy weather. Working to the N.W. the welcome at 6 p.m. luff put to the wind & shortened sail. Middle part spoke Bark Antelope later part light breeze from S.E. & raining by the wind with all sails set so ends

in Hudson Bay

Tuesday August 8th 1865

This day comes in with light breeze from S.E. & raining weather. Working by the wind working to the S. two sails in sight. Middle part strong breeze from N.W. Single reefed fore & mainsail. Later part light breeze from S.E. & cloudy weather. off Cape Fullerton five sails in sight

Wednesday August 9th

Commenced with light breeze from Southward & raining weather working to the S. Along the land. Brought a Bullwhale down in the water. At 6 p.m. spoke Bark Argy Haft. Middle part breeze fresh from N.W. Double reefed mainsail & Single reefed the foresail by the wind on different tacks. Later part strong breeze from S.W. & pleasant so one whale & lowered two boats see him one raising only. Land about 5 miles distant to the westward

Thursday Aug 10

These 24 hours commenced with strong breeze from S.W. with fresh squalls & changing weather by the wind on different tacks. See one whale going to the N. quick. Middle & later part strong breeze & cloudy weather. Made all sail. Six sails in sight so ends

Friday Aug 11

Commenced with strong breeze from S.W. & cloudy weather by the wind on different tacks working to the S. Along the land. Middle & later part light breeze from S.E. & raining weather

Saturday Aug 12

This day comes in with light breeze from S.E. & raining weather by the wind on different tacks off Cape Island. Spoke Ship Daniel Webster & let her have two shots. Middle & later part gale from S.E. with rain close in so she luffed at 11 A.M. under single reefed foresail & Double reefed mainsail & fore staysail. The wind veered so hauled up & A heavy sea on
