Remarks on Board Friday September 15th 1865

Thurs 24 hours commenced
with moderate breezes from the Westward & changeable
weather steering S. by W. with all sail set at 6 p.m.
Single Reefed mainsail & foresail. see a few
fishes. Middle & Laker part strong breeze from
W. & pleasant employed taring fore rig in so ends
Saturday Sept 16th

Commenced with
A brisk breeze from N.W. & pleasant weather
steering S. by W. employed scraping bone
Middle & Laker part brisk breeze from N.W.
& pleasant. Lat 50.10 N.

Sunday Sept 17th
This day comes
in with strong breeze from N.W. & pleasant
weather steering S. by W. Double Reefed mainsail
& single Reefed the fore. Employed scraping bone
Middle & Laker part light breeze from N.W. pleasant
finished scraping bone Lat 48.36 N. Long 45.30 W.
Monday Sept 18th

Thurs 24 hours
Commenced with light breeze from N. & pleasant
weather steering to the S. one sail in sight
steering to Middle part light breeze from S.W.
by the wind up W. by Laker part increased to a
gale double reefed foresail & close reefed mainsail
blowing heavy with rain so ends the day
Tuesday Sept 19th

A heavy gale
from W. with a large sea & rain losing the under
close reefed mainsail & double reefed fore. Balance
reefed the main at 10 p.m. close reefed the fore, 10 p.m.
S.W. Middle & Laker part A fresh gale from
N.W. with a large sea so ends Lat 47.57 N.

in North Atlantic Ocean
Wednesday Sept 20th 1865

Commenced with
A moderate gale from N.W. & cloudy weather losing
the under close reefed foresail & balance reefed main
at 3 p.m. Moderate & trade sail kept off S. by W.
Middle part light breeze from N.W. cloudy. A large swell
on port side, easing on the foresail & tore the reef a little
at 8 A.M. wind backed up fresh from the S. with rain
soon increased to a gale losing the under close reefed
foresail & balance reefed mainsail heading N. by N.
the day ending with a heavy gale from the S.W.

Thursday Sept 21st
This day comes in
with a heavy gale from W. with passing rain losing the
under close Reefed foresail & balance reefed mainsail
Barometer 29.6. Middle part fore moderate Laker
part A light gale from N.W. & bent the foresail
so repairs so ends this day

Friday Sept 22nd
Commenced with
A pleasant gale from N.W. & pleasant weather
losing the under balance reefed mainsail & storm
sail heading S. A large sea rising. Middle &
Laker part moderate heading S. by W. one sail in sight
Saturday Sept 23rd

This day comes in
with strong breeze from N.W. & cloudy weather
by the wind under easy sail heading S. by W. finished
foresail & bent it. Middle part light breeze from
N. & rain steering S. by W. Laker part strong
breeze from N.W. & rising took in mainsail & under
