Remarks on Board Saturday November 11th 1885-

Commenced with
A Moderate Breeze from the N.W. cloudy weather by
the wind on different tacks with all sail set Bottom
at 35 fathoms mud. Two Sails in Sight Middle W
Later part strong breeze & cloudy weather N.W. Murry
on duty well so ends this day

Sunday Nov 12th

Light breeze from
N.W. pleasant weather by the wind up N.W. by N. Black
Island in Sight Bearing N. Distance about 15 miles
Middle part light breeze & calm Later part
light breeze from S.W. pleasant Black Island
Bearing N. Distance about 15 miles so ends

Monday Nov 13th

Commenced with
Light breeze from S.W. pleasant weather N. bearing
N.W. by E. passed Black Island. Three sails in
Sight
