Monday July 4th 1864

These 24 hours commences

With light variable winds & calm foggy at times
Staying at E. James & Chamberlain duty Pick &
Number of icebergs in sight middle part calm
later part light breeze from E. & rising Steering
E. the watch employed in doing Esch duty so ends

Tuesday July 5th

commences

with a brisk breeze from E. & rising weather
Steering S.W. by E. passed a number of icebergs
at 6.30 a.m. Double reefed the foresail & mainsail
middle part strong breeze & rain later part
moderate & thick fog made sail. James & Chamberlain
on duty again so ends this day Long 47.37 W.

Wednesday July 6th

commences with

a brisk breeze from N.W. & foggy weather
Steering S.W. by E. the watch employed fixing
cutting gear at 6.30 a.m. took in mainsail &
fore topsail middle part strong breeze later part
moderate & foggy the watch employed at various jobs

Lat 52.34

Thursday July 7th

commences with

a moderate breeze from N. & foggy weather by the wind
up at 6. by E. under easy sail middle part a light
gale reefed the foresails a large swell on
later part more moderate so ends this day

Lat 54.07 S

Friday July 8th 1864

These 24 hours comes

in with moderate breeze from N. & cloudy weather Steering
by the wind up at 6. by E. under easy sail a few thick ones
middle part calm & fog later part light breeze from E. &
rain the watch variously employed so ends this day N. Obe

Saturday July 9th

commences with

moderate breeze from S.W. & rising weather Steering
S.W. by E. under easy sail the thick getting better middle
part wind hauled to S.W. & increased Steering S.W.
later part a gale from E. took in foresail & jib
so reefed the foresail so ends these 24 hours

Sunday July 10th

commences

with a moderate gale from S.W. & rain laging to
under double reefed foresail & foretopmast staydail up
N.W. by E. middle part moderate later part S.W. the mainsail
double reefed & jib by the wind heading S.W. by E. James
taken off duty Pick with vessel so ends this day N. Obe

Monday July 11th

this day comes

in with a moderate breeze from E. & variable weather
Steering S.W. under easy sail a large swell middle part
calm & pleasant later part light breeze from E. Steering
S.W. the watch variously employed the inner topsail part
diced together again so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday July 12th

commences

with a moderate breeze from E. & cloudy weather Steering
S.W. James & Chamberlain still off duty sick middle part
light breeze later part the same the watch variously
employed so ends this day
