

Schr Glacier Fog, Cruising in Hudson
Wednesday September 7th 1844

Commenced with light
breeze from the S. & pleasant weather by the wind working
to the S. along shore spoke Bark Inset Gibbs middle is
later part light air & fog three fairs in sight so ends
Thursday Sept 8th

Light variable
winds & pleasant weather bearing to the S. Along the land
the Starboard anchor ashore at 6 p.m. come on board
land distance about 4 miles 35 fathoms of water at
11 p.m. heaved up fresh from the N. Double reefed fore &
main sail & luffed to the wind at 5 p.m. kept off
for Sept island & 10 come to anchor in 8 fathoms
of water sent a boat ashore & got off some shovels
Friday Sept 9th

Commenced with
A brisk breeze from the N. & pleasant weather lying at
anchor at Sept island 5 miles taking at anchor here
middle part moderate later part light breeze getting
about 11 o'clock some of the Bark Antelope left here
Saturday Sept 10th

Commenced with
light air from the S. & pleasant weather at 8 p.m.
got underway in company with Bark Inset
Gibbs & Schr Cornelius bound to Marble Island
for winter quarters middle part light breeze from S.W.
Later part brisk breeze so ends this day
Sunday Sept 11th

Brisk breeze
from S.W. & pleasant weather Marble Island bearing S.W.
distance 15 miles working up to it middle part strong breeze
reefed foresail & main sail at 11 A.M. come to anchor to the
lee of the island in company with Schr Cornelius & Bark
Inset Gibbs so ends this day

Bay Remarks on Board

Monday September 12th 1844

Commenced with
Strong breeze from S. & foggy weather lying at anchor at Marble
island the Starboard boat ashore looking for a harbor
middle part moderate at 5 p.m. got underway & worked
to the westward of the island & come to anchor in a
small Bay to lay for the winter in company with
Bark only kept 11 Inset Gibbs & Schr Cornelius
A good harbor land looked so ends this day
Tuesday Sept 13th

Commenced with
A strong breeze from the S.E. & raining weather lying
with bark anchors down middle part strong breeze & rain
Later part moderate & rain landed some shovels for
the winter so ends this day
Wednesday Sept 14th

Commenced
with brisk breeze from the S.W. & variable weather
the surface where gunning & few deer here & ducks
game is very scarce here
Thursday Sept 15th

Commenced with
A gale from the N.W. & fair weather getting ready for
winter A few ashore gunning
Friday Sept 16th

Commenced with
Light breeze from the N.E. & pleasant weather harbor boat
away looking for Narves & wind boat around the island
looking for whales day ends with Snow
Saturday Sept 17th

Light winds
from N.E. & Snow employed clearing off Snow harbor
boat away got so ends this day
