

Schooner Mucir Log. Cruising
Friday August 4th 1865

Commenced with
A moderate gale from N.W. & cloudy weather
Cruising off Marble Island & sails in sight
Single reefed fore & mainsail middle part
which the same as the first later part moderate
& pleasant at 11 A.M. came to anchor off the S.
side & got the raft & shore for water so ends
Saturday Aug 5th

This day comes in
with light breeze from N.W. & pleasant weather
at 6 p.m. got the raft aboard & got under weigh
raised & a whale in shore & lowered three boats
for him at 10 p.m. came aboard without success
started off shore quick. Later part fresh breeze
from S.W. two boats ashore for water & one
boat in looking for whales so ends this day
Sunday Aug 6th

Commenced with
A strong breeze from S.W. & changeable weather
Working to the N. all the boats aboard employed at
working water middle part brisk breeze later
part light variable winds & cloudy weather spoke bark
Cory Vapt 6 sails in sight so ends this day
Monday August 7th

These 24 hours commenced
with strong breeze from S. & cloudy weather working
to the N. the M. came at 6 p.m. luffed
to the wind & shortened sail middle part spoke
bark Antelope later part light breeze from S.E.
& raining by the wind with all sails set so ends

in Hudson Bay
Tuesday August 8th 1865

While day comes in
with light breeze from S.E. & raining weather working
by the wind working to the N. two sails in sight middle
part strong breeze from N.W. Single reefed fore & mainsail
later part light breeze from N.W. cloudy weather off
cape fuller on fine sails in sight

Wednesday August 9th
Commenced with
Light breeze from Southward & raining weather working
to the S. Along the land saw 14 white bears
in the water. At 6 p.m. spoke bark Cory Vapt.
Middle part breeze fresh from N.W. Double reefed
mainsail & single reefed the foresail by the wind
on different tacks later part strong breeze from S.W.
& pleasant saw one whale & lowered two boats see him
one raising only land about 5 miles distant to the westward
Thursday Aug 10th

These 24 hours commenced
with strong breeze from S.W. with fresh squalls & changeable
weather by the wind on different tacks saw one whale going
to the N. quick middle & later part strong breeze &
cloudy weather made all sail two sails in sight so ends
Friday Aug 11th

Commenced with
Strong breeze from S.W. & cloudy weather by the wind on
different tacks working to the N. Along the land middle &
later part light breeze from S.E. & raining weather
Saturday Aug 12th

This day comes in
with light breeze from S.E. & raining weather by the
wind on different tacks off depo island spoke ship
Daniel Webster let her have two shots middle &
gale from S.E. with rain close in so the tart
at 11 p.m. under single reefed foresail &
Double reefed mainsail & fore staysail the wind
veered to eastward & a heavy sea on
