

Shipboard Glacier Log, New Bound
Remarks on Board Tuesday August 29th 1865

This day comes in with light breeze from E. & changeable weather by the wind up N.E. by N. towards island in sight Bearing S. Distance about 15 miles. Middle part light breeze from N.W. bearing E. & employed setting up the main rig in other jobs so ends this day.

Wednesday Aug 30th

Commenced with moderate breeze from N.W. & pleasant weather steering along the coast to eastward passed Mansfield Island. Employed setting up main rig in spoke bark Concordia Middle part strong breeze & cloudy later part light breeze pleasant spoke bark Antelope & Concordia. Employed rustling fore rig in & setting head rig in so ends this day.

Thursday Aug 31st

This day comes in with light breeze from E. & calm pleasant weather in Hudson Strait working down on the N. shore middle part light breeze & pleasant later part strong breeze & cloudy land to the distance about 10 miles so ends.

Friday Sept 1st

Commenced with a light gale from E. & slightly weather by the wind on different tack at 4 A.M. single reefed mainsail & fousail at 7 A.M. gale increased & double reefed & took bark off the jib & large sea running. Middle part a fresh gale later part moderate & cloudy weather steering by compass with wind from the eastward land distance about 15 miles to the N.W. so ends this day.

Port of Hudson Bay

Saturday September 2nd 1865

Commenced with moderate breeze from E. & cloudy weather steering in the straits land in sight each side. A few icebergs middle part light breeze & passing rain passed a number of large pieces of ice later part cloudy scattering ice in sight & land off the Starboard beam so ends this day.

Sunday Sept 3rd

This day comes in with light breeze from N.W. & cloudy weather steering by compass bark Antelope in sight & scattering ice upper Savage Island bearing E. Distance about 20 miles. Went tonight to meet Starboard the watch employed rustling fore rig in Middle part strong breeze at 1 P.M. & thick fog lapped so the wind abate at 4 P.M. light up & kept off passed a few icebergs running down the N. shore so ends this day.

Monday Sept 4th

Came in with strong breeze from N.W. & changeable weather steering by E. & two miles in sight Resolution Island bearing N.E. Distance about 25 miles middle part light breeze & large swell later part strong breeze from E.N.E. with snow squalls passed the island & hauled by the wind to the N.E. Bound to Cumberland inlet. Single reefed fore & mainsail five sails in sight so ends.

Tuesday Sept 5th

This day comes in with strong breeze from E.N.E. with passing snow squalls by the wind under easy sail up N.E. & large swell on 5 sails in sight Bound to the north middle part light breeze from N.W. & pleasant steering N.E. later part the same spoke bark Antelope employed rustling fore rig in so ends this day.
