

Schooner *Lucifer* Log. Cruising  
Remarks on Board Friday September 15<sup>th</sup> 1845

These 24 hours commenced  
with moderate breezes from the Westward & changeable  
weather Steering S. by W. with all sail set at 6 p.m.  
Single Reefed Mainsail & Foresail. see a few  
puffs of middle & later part of strong breeze from  
W. & pleasant employed taring fore rigging & rigging  
Saturday Sept 16<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with  
A brisk breeze from N.W. & pleasant weather  
Steering S. by W. employed scraping bone  
middle & later part. Brisk breeze from N.W.  
& pleasant. Lat 50.10 N.

Sunday Sept 17<sup>th</sup>  
This day comes  
in with strong breeze from N.W. & pleasant  
weather Steering S. by W. Single Reefed Mainsail  
& Single Reefed the fore employed. Scraping bone  
middle & later part light breeze from N. & pleasant  
finished scraping bone Lat 48.56 N. Long 45.30 W.

Monday Sept 18<sup>th</sup>  
These 24 hours  
Commenced with light breezes from N. & pleasant  
weather Steering to the N. one sail in sight  
Steering N. Middle part light breeze from N.W.  
by the wind up N. by E. Later part increased to a  
gale double reefed foresail & close reefed mainsail  
blowing heavy with rain so ends this day

Tuesday Sept 19<sup>th</sup>  
A heavy gale  
from W. with a large sea in rain being to under  
close reefed Mainsail & double reefed fore. Balance  
reefed the main at 10 p.m. close reefed the fore, 10 p.m.  
S.S.W. Middle & later part a fresh gale from  
N.W. with a large sea so ends Lat 47.57 N.

in North Atlantic Ocean  
Wednesday Sept 20<sup>th</sup> 1845

Commenced with  
A moderate gale from N.W. & cloudy weather being  
to under close reefed Foresail & Balance reefed main  
at 3 p.m. moderated & made sail & kept off S. by W.  
Middle part light breeze from N.W. & cloudy. A large swell  
on pushed coming on the foresail & tore the reef a little  
at 8 A.M. wind backed up fresh from the S. with rain  
soon increased to a gale being to under close reefed  
Foresail & Balance reefed Mainsail heading N. by W.  
the day ending with a heavy gale from the S.W.

Thursday Sept 21<sup>st</sup>  
This day comes in  
with a heavy gale from W. with passing rain being to  
under close reefed Foresail & Balance reefed Mainsail  
Barometer 29.60 Middle part breeze moderate later  
part a light gale from N.W. & under the foresail  
so ends this day

Friday Sept 22<sup>nd</sup>  
Commenced with  
A pleasant gale from N.W. & pleasant weather  
Steering to under close reefed Mainsail & storm  
sail heading N. A large sea rising middle &  
later part moderate heading S. by W. one sail in sight  
Saturday Sept 23<sup>rd</sup>

This day comes in  
with strong breeze from N.W. & cloudy weather  
by the wind under easy sail heading S. by W. finished  
foresail & bent it Middle part light breeze from  
N. & rain Steering S. by W. Later part strong  
breeze from N.W. & rain took in to main sail & went
