

Schooner Glacier Log  
 Remarks on Board Thursday October 19<sup>th</sup> 1865

Commenced with  
 Strong breeze from N.W. squally weather steering  
 by the wind under easy sail heading N. by E.  
 Middle part light breeze pleasant later part  
 Light air & calm employed stowing down oil  
 & other jobs so ends this day

Friday Oct 20<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours commenced  
 with light air from the N. by E. & cloudy  
 weather by the wind on different tacks two sails  
 in sight finished stowing down the two stales  
 made 20 lbs middle part strong breeze from  
 N.W. by E. single reefed fore & main sail later part  
 A fresh gale laying to under balance reefed  
 main sail & double reefed fore sail Barometer  
 29.7 falling so ends this day

Saturday Oct 21<sup>st</sup>

This day comes in  
 with a fresh gale from S.W. by W. cloudy weather  
 laying to in the gulf stream under balance  
 reefed fore sail & double reefed fore sail &  
 large sea running at 2 p.m. close reefed the fore  
 middle part moderate & squally later part the  
 wind veered to N. by W. & around heading N.W. by W.

Sunday Oct 22<sup>nd</sup>

Commenced with  
 A strong breeze from N. by E. squally weather by  
 the wind under easy sail up S.W. by E. middle  
 & later part A moderate gale from the N.W. by N.  
 & squally with rain heading N.W. so ends this  
 day Lat 39.53. Long 52.16 W.

Homeward Bound

Remarks on Board Monday October 23<sup>rd</sup> 1865

These 24 hours commenced  
 with A strong breeze from N.W. by N. squally weather  
 by the wind up S.W. middle part pleasant later part  
 light breeze cloudy made all sail employed boiling  
 Blushfish & some Herrings off duty sick so ends this day  
 Lat 38.15 W. Long 51.44 W.

Tuesday Oct 24<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with light  
 air from N. by E. cloudy weather & large swell on  
 steering by the wind heading N.W. by N. fore & main  
 Boiling The Blushfish middle part strong breeze  
 from N.W. by E. by the wind up N.W. by N. single reefed  
 later part wind hauled to N.W. & around heading  
 N. by E. so ends this day

Wednesday Oct 25<sup>th</sup>

This day comes in  
 with light breeze from N.W. by W. & passing rain  
 squally steering by the wind heading N.W. & large  
 swell from the N.W. & fair weather Blush still off duty  
 sick & some Herrings middle part light breeze  
 from N. later part light breeze from N.W. & rain  
 steering N.W. by N. employed filling sub water in  
 the after hold to trim her by the stern so ends  
 this day

Thursday Oct 26<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with  
 A brisk breeze from the N.W. & rainy weather steering  
 N.W. by N. working the main sail at 6 p.m. wind increased  
 & double reefed the fore sail one sail in sight to the N.  
 middle part moderate & rainy passed the lead rope  
 of the fore sail later part light breeze from Eastward  
 & rain. the sick about the same so ends this day
