Commenced with
A Moderate Breeze from the N. by cloudy weather by
the wind on different tacks with all sail set. Hatteras
at 35 fathoms. Sound. Two Sails in Sight. Middle of
Latter part Strong haze & cloudy weather. M. M. M. M.
on duty well so ends this day.

Sunday Nov 12th

Light breeze from
N. by pleasant weather by the wind up N. by N. Black
Island in Sight Bearing N. Distance about 15 miles
Middle part Light breeze & calm. Latter part
Light breeze from N. W. by pleasant. Black Island
Bearing N. Distance about 15 miles. No wind.

Monday Nov 13th

Commenced with
Light breeze from N. W. by pleasant weather. Bearing
N. by E. passed Black Island. Three sails in
Sight.
