

July 22 This day commences with
light airs from S & calm
Working to the S & on different tacks
At 3 A.M. got sounding in 10 fath
were ship to W. at P.M. light breeze
from S.W. steering E S E at 7 P.M.
South Shoal Light boat bore N E 6 miles
dist. employed the through the day breaking
out main hold and putting on Chafers gear

July 23rd There 24 hours we have had
light airs from the S and W. and pleasant
weather. Steered E by S under
all sail. Passed many fishermen
Lat 41-16 N. Long 68-25 W.

July 24th The first part of these 24
hours we had it calm and pleasant
latter part light breeze from N E and
cloudy. Employed breaking out the fore
and after hold. Several fishermen in
sight - Lat 41-04 N Long 68-17

July 25th Commences with fresh breeze
from S & S E and hazy weather. Reaching
S E by the wind 6 A.M. blowing strong
with rain. Purlied the light sails.
At noon tacked ship. Soon after wind
hauled to S. S. E. set the light sails and
steered S E by E.

Wed July 26 All the 24 hours we have
had a fresh breeze from S. and cloudy
steering E by S under all sail. Employed
on the rigging and other jobs
Lat 41-34 N. Long 64-58 W.

Thurs July 27 Commences with fresh
breeze from S. and cloudy with light
rain showers. Middle and latter
part light wind at N. S. W. steering E
under all sail. Employed on the rigging
and making boat sail
Lat 42-50 N Long 62-21 W.

Friday July 28th First light winds
from S and E and pleasant. Latter
part light airs from W. and foggy
Employed on the rigging and boats
Lat 42-55 N Long 60-57 W.

Sat July 29th First part of this
day we had light breeze from W.
and cloudy. Middle and latter parts
calm and foggy with light rain.
Employed on the rigging
Lat 43-15 N Long 59-07 W.
