

Sunday July 30th First part of this day we had it calm and thick fog. At 4 P.M. we got a light breeze from S. - steering by the wind.

Monday July 31st Commences with and thick fog. Middle and last parts light breeze from S. - and thick fog. Employed making sheet and overhauling whaling gear. Steering S. & S.

Tuesday July Aug 1st Commences with a light breeze from S. and thick fog. Middle part light up a little. Latter part moderate breeze from S. and thick weather. Employed breaking out water and lashing up cutting pendants. Long 59-04 W. Lat 43-15 N.

Wed July Aug 2nd Commences with a moderate breeze from S. and thick fog. Steering S. & S. by the wind. At noon passed several fishermen spoke one who reported land ahead. Tacked ship and stood to S. W. Latter part fresh breeze at S. S. E. and thick fog. Struck the Bank this morning at 6.

Thursday Aug 3rd Commences with a strong breeze at S. E. and thick fog. At 11 A.M. blowing strong with heavy rain. furled the light sails and reefed the topsails. Leading S. W. by the wind, at 30 wind hauled to W. were ship and made sail. Latter part wind moderate at N. - and thick fog - steering S. E. by E. fog under all sails. Lat 45-33 - Long 51-51 W.

Friday Aug 4th Commences with a moderate breeze from W. with thick fog. Steering S. E. by E. Middle part light up. Steered S. N. E. Latter part wind hauled to N. - Leading S. by the wind under all sail. Lat 47-03 W. Long 48-04 W.

Saturday Aug 5th Commences with light airs from N. - and cloudy. Leading S. by the wind. At 11 A.M. wind hauled to S. W. steered N. - under all sail. Latter part strong breeze from the same quarter with thick fog. Employed breaking out the after hold. Pickled two 66 onions, and secured out molasses - found one cask of molasses of 126 Gallons - which had leaked out with the exception of a few Gallons. Lat 48-06 N. Long 50-00 W.
