

Sunday Aug 6<sup>th</sup>

Commences with a fresh breeze from S.W. Steering N by E under all sail. Middle part heavy thunder showers furled the light sails. At 11 AM wind S.E. with rain under all sail. At 1 PM wind hauled to E.N.E. heading N by E by the wind. Lat 49-45

Monday Aug 7<sup>th</sup>

Commences with a strong breeze at N.E. soon after wind backed to N.W. and blew strong. Middle watch furled light sails. In sail and reefed. At 11 AM lowering heavy close reef. At 1 PM furled the fore-topmast and close reefed the main. Ship heading to N.E. One sail in sight on the same tack. At 10 PM to under close reefed in top sail.

Tues Aug 8<sup>th</sup>

This commences with a heavy gale from N.W. and thick weather. Ship heading to N.E. under close reefed in topmast and fore-top, and amryze. Stay under. Latter part more moderate. Tacked ship to the N.W. set the fore-topmast and courses.

Wed Aug 9<sup>th</sup>

Commences with a fresh gale from N. and thick fog. Middle and last part moderate breeze and clear weather. Ship working to wind on different tacks. Lat 47-50 N - Long 57-26 W.

Thurs Aug 10<sup>th</sup>

First part of this day we had light winds from E and thick fog. Middle and latter parts we had calm and light air from E.W. Steering under all sail. Employed building a crew's nest at the mast head and other jobs on the rigging. Saw small icebergs. Lat 52-35 N - Long 52-09 W.

Friday Aug 11<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light air from S. and cloudy. Middle and last part fresh breeze from S.W. and clear weather. Employed making boat covers and breaking out flour. Lat 53-05 N - Long 54-02 W. Saw several icebergs.

Saturday Aug 12

All these 24 hours we have had a strong breeze from S.W. and clear weather. Steering N by E under all sail. Employed on the rigging and boats. Lat 55-42 N - Long 55-55 W.

Sunday Aug 13<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light breeze from S.W. and pleasant weather. Middle part calm. Latter strong breeze from N.W. and thick fog. Ship working to wind on different tacks.
