

Monday Aug 14  
Commences with a fresh breeze from N and thick fog. Ship heading S by the wind under all sail. Middle part calm took to N W. Latter part light breeze from S and pleasant weather. Employed on the rigging and making loab stails.  
Lat 56-30 N Long 54-05 W

Tuesday Aug 15<sup>th</sup>  
First part of this day we had light airs from S and pleasant weather. Latter part fresh breeze S W and thick fog. Employed baking out bread and water.  
Lat 56-5 N Long 54-05 W

Wed Aug 16  
All these 24 hours we have had a fresh breeze from S W and thick fog first part. Latter part clear. Passed a very large iceberge.  
Lat 58-20 N Long 60-08 W

Thurs 17<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with a fresh breeze from S W. Steering S by E or E. pleasant weather. 3 P M wind suddenly shifted to N and cloudy. 6 P M had red ship headed S by E by compass. Four points west. Lat 59-20 N Long 62-22 W.  
Passed many Bergs

Friday Aug 18<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with a light breeze from N W. weather thick and rainy. 8 A M set light up. Saw land 25 miles distant bearing N. Ship heading to the S E by the wind under all sail. Several ice bergs in sight. Several men on the sick list. One Bailey has been off duty sick since we sailed.

Saturday Aug 19<sup>th</sup>  
The first and middle part of this day we had light and variable winds and calm with rain and thick fog. Latter wind headed to S E. Steered N E by N under all sail.

Sunday Aug 20<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with light breeze from S E and cloudy. Steering S by E. Latter part light air S W and cloudy. Ship heading N W by the wind. Lat 60-40 N

Monday Aug 21<sup>st</sup>  
First part light and variable winds from N and E and cloudy with some rain. Ship working N W. Middle light air from E. Latter part calm and clear. Sighted Resolute Island bearing N E by compass 25 miles distant. Cape West N by N 30 miles distant. Employed breaking out mullorren & meat and overhauling cutting gear.  
Lat 61-10 N Long 65-18 W
