

Bark Glace. Hudson Bay
Thursday Aug 31

Commences with a fresh gale from N and cloudy. Steering N N W. by Compass & point, var. N. At noon sighted Southampton Island bearing N 10 S - dist. Latter part light airs and pleasant.

Lat 62-07 N Long 83-47 W.

Friday Aug Sept 1st

First part light airs from E and pleasant. Middle part light wind from N N E and thick fog. Latter wind veered to S and hauled up. Steering N N W.

Lat 62-22 N Long 85-24 W.

Saturday Sept 2

Commences with a fresh breeze from N E and cloudy. Middle part thick and rainy. Latter strong wind from N with thick and rainy weather till in the light sail. Steering N N W by W.

Sunday Sept 3

Commences fresh breeze from N and thick fog. Steering N N W. At daylight made the land near Chesterfield. Steered along the shore towards Cape Fox. At 4 P.M. the Cape in sight bearing S. Wind light and puffing.

Monday Sept 4th

These 24 hours we have had light airs from N - W and cloudy. Ship near Cape Fulerton working E and along the coast. At noon left went on shore. Soon after the bar and mast lowered on chase of a whale going quick to windward - saw him but once.

Tuesday Sept 5th

First part light airs from N and calm. Latter fresh breeze from same quarter and cloudy. Ship near Cape Fulerton working to windward by tacks. Awoke out water and back.

Wed. Sept 6th

Commences with light breeze from N W. Middle part strong wind from N W. Latter calm and cloudy. Ship working to windward by tacks. Put up the stores today. Lat 63-45 N Long 88-25 W.

Thursday Sept 7th

First part calm. Middle and latter calm. Light breeze from S and pleasant. Steering E S E along the shore which bears N 60 S - dist. Lat 63-59 N. Long 90-21 W. Strong head current. At sundown saw a whale near bow to bearing S E.
