

Marble Island

Thursday Sept 14th

This day we have had a strong gale from S.E. with snow at S.A. let go the 2^d anchor. Latter part at moderated and the snow ceased to fall.

Friday Sept 15th

Commences with a strong gale at S.E. Middle and latter part strong wind from N. and freezing cold. P.M. put the spare spar ashore.

Saturday Sept 16th

Commences with strong gale from N. Middle and latter part light breeze from W. and cloudy with light snow. Sent down top gallant and royal yards. S.P. hoisted up the 2^d anchor. At 9 A.M. Capt. and 2^d mate left the ship with two boats to go to the main land.

Sunday Sept 17th

First part - light air from N.W. with snow. Latter ^{part} fresh breeze from N.W. and clear overhead.

Monday Sept 18th

This day we have a fresh breeze from N.W. and pleasant. Employed sloping up the running rigging.

Tuesday Sept 19th

This day we have a fresh breeze from N.W. and cloudy. Put some shacks in shore. At 12 M. Capt. and 2^d mate returned to the ship. Brought some salmon and four natives.

Wednesday Sept 20th

Commences with a light breeze from N.E. Middle and latter part fresh breeze from S. and cloudy. At 9 A.M. Capt. and 3^d mate left the ship with two boats to go to the main land. 2 P.M. rose up and cleared the port anchor. 7 P.M. blowing strong from S.E. let go 2^d anchor.

Thursday Sept 21st

There 24 hours we have a strong gale S.E. and cloudy. A heavy swell running in the harbor at high water. Ship riding at both anchors with 30 fath on the large one and 15 fath on the small one.

Friday Sept 22

This day we have had a strong gale from S.E. and cloudy. Bark riding at two anchors.

Saturday Sept 23

To day we have had a strong gale from N.E. and cloudy with light snow squalls. Ship riding at two anchors.
