

Marble Island

Sunday Sept 24th

These 24 hours we have had a strong gale from S.E. and thick foggy weather with light rain. Ship riding at two anchors.

Monday Sept 25th

Strong wind from S.E. and cloudy weather. Ship anchored the same as yesterday.

Tuesday Sept 26th

This day commences with a strong breeze at S.E. Middle and latter parts light air from E. and cloudy. At 10 A.M. the Capt and boats returned onboard. They brought about 350 lbs of Deer meat and 25 lbs of Salmon.

Wednesday Sept 27th

This day commences with light air from S. and cloudy. Middle and latter parts strong wind from the same quarter with thick weather and rain. Broke out the run to find stone linings, could not find them.

Thursday Sept 28th

Commences with a strong breeze S. and thick weather. Latter part light wind from W. and pleasant weather.

Friday Sept 29th

Commences light air from S. with thick fog. Hoist the 2^d anchor. P.M. Blowing strong from S.E. let go the 2^d anchor. Lar and Mast boats went over to the main land.

Sat Sept 30th

Light wind from S. with thick fog. At noon wind hauled to W. and blew strong. Ship riding at both anchors.

Sunday Oct 1st

Commences with a strong wind from S.W. and clear weather. At noon arrived onboard with the two boats brought about 60 lbs of Deer meat and a bushel of berries. Latter part more moderate.

Mon - Oct 2nd

This day we have had light southerly wind and pleasant weather. At noon the Capt and 2^d mate started with the Lar Boat for the main land. P.M. hove up the 2^d anchor and cleared it.

Tuesday Oct 3rd

This day commences with a fresh breeze from S. with thick rainy weather. P.M. wind hauled to N. with snow squalls. Let go the 2^d anchor. Broke out water and coal. At dark blowing a strong gale.
