

Marble Island

Wednesday Oct 4<sup>th</sup>

This day we have a heavy gale from N with clear weather. Ship riding with <sup>both</sup> anchors.

Thursday Oct 5<sup>th</sup>

Commences with a strong gale at 11. Middle part gale continuing from N W with snow squalls. Latter part the gale continues from N E W with snow squalls. Ship riding with both anchors. At noon the air was 13° below freezing ice making on the water line.

Friday Oct 6<sup>th</sup>

All these 24 hours we have had a strong gale from S W with snow squalls. Ship riding with both anchors. The Capt and 2<sup>d</sup> mate not returned yet.

Saturday Oct 7<sup>th</sup>

This day commences with a strong gale from S W with snow squalls. Latter part moderate gale from W and clear weather. At 1 P M the Capt and 2<sup>d</sup> mate and boat crew returned to the ship. Brought deer meat and other game.

Sunday Oct 8<sup>th</sup>

This day we have a strong gale from W and cloudy - at dusk a boat crew of natives came on board.

Monday Oct 9<sup>th</sup>

Commences with a moderate gale from S W and pleasant weather. Latter part moderate wind from S - and cloudy. At 2 o'clock above zero.

Tuesday Oct 10

Commences with a moderate gale from S E with snow. Middle part wind at N E with snow falling rapidly. Latter part wind N W and clear weather. At 2 o'clock above zero.

Wednesday Oct 11

This day commences with a strong wind from N E with snow. Latter part wind from N and cloudy. Hoisted up the 2<sup>d</sup> anchor. Secured it and dropped it again.

At 2 o'clock above zero.

Thursday Oct 12<sup>th</sup>

Had light breeze from N E and cloudy. Middle and latter part light and variable wind from S -.

At 2 o'clock above zero.

Friday Oct 13<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours we have had light and variable wind and cloudy. At dusk wind to N E. If off the land and piled up the loose lumber left there.
