March 5 Thursday Feb 5th 1872

This day we have had a fresh breeze from S.W. with pleasant weather.

March 6 Friday Feb 6th

This day we have had a fresh gale from N.W. with hazy weather.

March 7 Saturday Feb 7th

This day we have had a strong gale from N.W. the air thick with frost.

March 8 Sunday Feb 8th

The gale continues the same as yesterday. The air thick with frost and drifting snow.

March 9 Monday Feb 9th

The gale continues from the same quarter but has moderated since yesterday. The weather has cleared of overhead but still thick haze.

March 10 Tuesday Feb 10th

The gale continues strong from N.W. The weather thick and intensely cold.

Winter Quarters 1872

March Wednesday Feb 13th

Commences with a fresh breeze from N.W. and cloudy latter part. Moderate and pleasant.

March Thursday Feb 14th

This day commences calm and pleasant. Latter part fresh breeze from S.W.

Friday March 15th

This day we have had a strong gale from N.W. The air thick with drifting snow and frost.

Saturday March 16th

Commences with a light breeze from N.W. Latter part a fresh breeze from the same quarter with thick hazy weather.

Sunday March 17th

This day commences with a light breeze from N. with clear weather. Latter light breeze from S.W. with smoky weather. Another man later has the scurvy.
