Monday March 18th 1872

This day commences with a fresh breeze from N. and clear weather. Latter part light breeze from N.W. and pleasant. A party of natives came on board from the main land. They brought a quantity of Trout and several pieces of Deer Meat.

Tuesday March 19th

Strong gale from N.W.

22-B

with thick hazy weather

Wednesday March 20th

Fresh breeze from N.W. and pleasant weather. The natives all left the ship this morning except those that belong to the ship. Towards two more arrived from the main land with a load of skins from both parties we got 8 musk ox skins 5 Wolf do. 35 Fox do. 1 Marmoset 1 Bear do.

30-B

Thursday March 21st

Light breeze from N.W. and pleasant weather. Got off a cask of old Bread from the shore. Served out molasses.

16-B

Winter Quarters

Friday March 22nd 1872

This day we have had a strong gale from N.W. with thick foggy weather.

Saturday March 23rd

This day we have had a moderate gale at N.W. with thick and a light fall of snow. Three of our natives and two of our men went on to the main land and brought back their bedding and 27 fish.

2-B

Sunday March 24th

The wind has been light a variable from N. to S.W. The weather hazy.

1-B

Monday March 25th

Light air from S. Breeze thick. Latter part clear. Employed hauling ice.

1-B

Tuesday March 26th

This day the wind has been light from S.E. first part clear and latter part cloudy. Cleared out the boats and other jobs.

Wednesday March 27th

This day commences with a strong gale from N. with snow. Towards sundown it moderated and light up a little.
