This day wind veering S to E and snowing most all day. Employed stowing down coal and getting H ready for the Floe

Saturday Apr 13th

This day we have had fresh breeze from W. First part cloudy latter part clear. Painted the Boats inside and cut out the rudders

Sunday Apr 14th

Today we have a fresh breeze from N with clear weather. The weather is cold and the spring appears to be backward. Several natives arrived from the mainland

Monday Apr 15th

This day began pleasant calm and cold. Latter part we had a light breeze from S.W. Employed painting the Boats outside. Bought of the natives that came yesterday
