

Saturday May 4th

Commenced with fine weather from N.E. Capt started with a boat load of provisions for the east end at the same time 2 boats left the east end to come to the ship for provisions. But the Capt. near the ship, started back in company. Came on a violent and sudden snow storm. Healed on the shore - obliged to land and haul up the boats. Capt walked to ship the rest to camp.

Sunday May 5th

Commenced with fresh breeze from S.W. and cloudy weather. A.M. hauled to N.W. and blowing very heavy. Bar. 29. Latter wind hauled more to W. and moderated.

Monday May 6th

First part strong wind from W. and fine weather. Employed aboard ship - Got out of provisions at the Camp - Started for the ship with the Star boat to get our provisions and boats that was left on the point the ice on the shore so we had to haul up the boat and walk to the ship for a sled - Arrived at 6 P.M. at the

Tuesday May 7th

Came with fresh gale from N.W. 2 A.M. 3 Boats crews started with a sled to get the provisions and later to the camp. - Arrived at camp at 7-30 A.M. gale continues strong through the day.

Wednesday May 8th

Strong gale from N.W. and pleasant weather. At camp found the remains of an old house. Skidded the lumber to camp and built a galley.

Thursday May 9th

Fresh breeze from W. and pleasant weather. Latter part the same repairing, casks &c.

Friday May 10th

Strong breeze from W. and pleasant weather - At camp the boats cruised off for whale run - none but found much young ice.

Saturday May 11

Came with light air and fine weather from W. Capt started for the east end and got shot by the young ice. Landed his provisions and returned to ship.
