

Wed. May 22<sup>nd</sup>

Fresh breeze from N.W. and pleasant weather. Packs in sight. Stowed provisions with bottles of fresh water. At camp some of the men are still very sick.

Thur. May 23<sup>rd</sup>

Fresh breeze from N.W. and clear weather. Middle part overcast. Latter part breeze from W. At camp boats off cruising. Star boat got 2 Walrus. Star boat B. Most struck one got slow and dead.

Friday May 24<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with fresh breeze and cloudy. Latter part light breeze from W. with snow.

Saturday May 25<sup>th</sup>

Light wind from W. and pleasant weather. Natives shot a Bear. At camp Capt arrived to day with natives boats crew and back the blubber of the Walrus. 2<sup>nd</sup> mate went with him to get fresh. P.M. Star and Lar boats cruising. Lar boat got a Walrus - 6 P.M. 2<sup>nd</sup> mate returned from ship.

Sunday May 26<sup>th</sup>

Calm with little light air from S.W. and fog. Middle part with breeze from S. and cloudy. Latter part the same.

Monday May 27<sup>th</sup>

Calm with light air from N.E. and cloudy. Middle and latter parts wind S.W. At camp Star and Lar boats off cruising. 2<sup>nd</sup> boat repairing. 3<sup>rd</sup> mate reports having seen a whale.

Tuesday May 28<sup>th</sup>

Light air from W. and cloudy. Smoked ship to day. Saw a whale to day for the first time. At camp boats off cruising. At 4 P.M. saw a small whale one rising.

Wed. May 29<sup>th</sup>

Light air from N.E. and cloudy. 3<sup>rd</sup> mate came to ship with some Walrus blubber - boots back some meat.

Thur. May 30<sup>th</sup>

Calm and hazy weather. got up 2 casks of water. At camp the packs close on shore.
