Saturday June 1st
Comes with fresh breeze and fog
from S.W. - Mincing Walrus
Blubber. Latter part light air

Sunday June 2nd
Light breeze from N.W. and
pleasant, Latter part calm, at low
tide day the pack set off a little
2 men started for the coal and provisions
he but the Capt coming with some
and returns with him

Monday June 3rd
Comes with strong breeze from S.W.
with snow pack in Latter part
strong wind from N.W. to N.W.
pack set off a little

Tuesday June 4th
Fresh breeze from N.W. and clear
weather - 15 natives came to the shore
from the main land - Latter part
light breeze

Wed - June 5th
Comes with light air from W
and fine weather. Latter part light
air from S. Sent a boat to the
East end. At camp boats off evening
Lar boat got a Walrus

Thurs June 6th
Light breeze and fine weather from
W. Natives went back to day
At camp by A.M. boats chasing
a whale off the point. Star boat
struck a calf - towed to the shore
and took Blubber off. Made 24 blubber

Friday June 7th
Comes with light air from S with
fine weather. Mid part wind S.
with snow squalls. Latter part strong
wind from N.E. packs in - At camp
by A.M. chased a whale off the point
whale went quick to move

Sat June 8th
Strong wind from S.E. with weather
no water in sight - Steward &
Cooper went to E. end of Island
by land. Latter part wind S.
with rain
