

Sunday June 9<sup>th</sup>  
Com - with with strong breeze and  
rain from ~~SW~~ Natives got back  
to ship with boats. 3 Mote came  
to ship with Blubber of a calf  
Latter strong gale raining hard

Monday June 10<sup>th</sup>  
Strong wind from N and over  
pack in sight. At camp saw an  
M. boat, <sup>crew</sup> went across the <sup>harbor</sup> to get coal  
for Blacksmiths purposes

Tuesday June 11<sup>th</sup>  
Fresh gale NE and cloudy  
the pack close in

Wed June 12<sup>th</sup>  
Strong gale from N with clear  
weather. got off 25 lbs water  
No water in ~~the~~ sight but  
a little abreast of the Harbor

Thurs June 13  
Strong gales from N and clear  
weather. No water in sight  
Boiled out 8 lbs of Walrus oil

Friday June 14  
Com - with strong breeze and fine  
weather from N pack still in  
Latter part calm

Saturday June 15<sup>th</sup> 1872  
Com with fresh breeze from SW with  
the pack in no water in sight  
Saw a whale this morning no chance to get  
a boat off

Sunday June 16<sup>th</sup>  
Com - with strong breeze and rain from  
SE - 2 Boat crews came to the ship  
from the East side being out of provisions  
that and boats <sup>crew</sup> took to take care of boats  
having food for 24 hours. Pack in no  
water in sight

Monday 17<sup>th</sup>  
Com - with fresh breeze and rain  
from SE. Latter part thick fog  
and calm, Got off 2 casks of water

Tuesday June 18<sup>th</sup>  
Com - with a strong breeze and good  
weather from N. The pack set off about  
5 hrs. The 2 Boat crews went back with  
the spar boat and provisions. Saw a calf  
off the harbor. Sent the natives the  
other side of the Island for the boat  
At camp, but of provisions started  
for the ship in boat and another in two  
half way met the other 2 boat crews coming  
with provisions returned to camp
