

Winter Quarter Marble Blm

Sat June 28th

Fresh breeze from N E and pleasant
weather. weather calm. Lays sawing
cut ship and taring down.

Sat June 29th

Strong wind from S W and
clear weather. Got off 2 casks of oil
and are sawing cut ship. 10 A M
in so the ship swung to her anchor.
The rest of the day employed filling salt
water under deck room stowing hold
and getting ready for sea.

Sun June 30th

Strong breeze from N E and pleasant
cut the ship ahead to her anchors
and hove up stern anchor. Finished
taring rigging. Paid off the natives
with a boat and other things. at 1 P M
hove up Port anchor and steered towards
The E - Eand with fair wind and fine
weather. 4 P M lowered off the E. Duff
for Walrus got six Star 2 for Boat 1 W.
Boat 3. Latter weather the same strong N

Monday July 1st

Calm with light breezes from S W
and fine weather. Made the pack, Cape point
in sight - stowing along the pack to the N
5 P M lowered for Walrus got six each
boat 2 - Latter part land aback under
short sail.

Under way Bound toward Depot Island

Tuesday July 2nd

Calm with light breeze from with rain
showers. Middle part light air calm
and pleasant. Ship north of Chesterfield
Islet heading in for the land which is N E
dist bearing N W. Latter part light filling
air and calm. Land 12 miles dist. Large patches
of snow by

Wed July 3rd

Calm with light variable air from S W to
E ship working to N E between the Rock
and Land. Middle part light air and
calm from S to E. 1 A M 15 miles E
of Chesterfield found the Rock made on
the Land so we could not pass in that
direction kept away to S W. Latter part calm
Land and Rock in sight.

Thurs July 4th

Calm with light air from N E with
rain showers. Middle part fresh breeze
from N W with passing clouds. Ship
working to N E. Latter part weather
the same. Lowered twice for whales
going quick to windward.
