

Friday July 5th 1872
 First strong breeze from W with rain
 squalls - Ship in a bay 20 mls E. of
 Chertfield Island 5 mls E. of lower for a while
 chased until 10 AM without success
 Middle part light air and good weather
 from N.W. latter calm calm and light
 air from N. Ship working to E. in
 between the ice and land
 Lat. 63-52 N Long 91-08 W.

Saturday July 6th
 Comes with light variable wind from
 N to W and fine weather Middle
 part light breeze from S.W. latter part
 light air from S.W. and pleasant
 ship near Whale point
 Lat by obs 64-25 N Long by Chron 88-54 W.

Sunday July 7th
 Comes with calm and pleasant
 saw 3 Whales going quick to S.W.
 Middle part light variable air
 from S.W. Ship working between
 the ice and land which is about 20 mls
 apart. Latter part light breeze from
 N.E. steering S.W. for Cape Dalton
 25 mls. distant
 Lat by obs 64-18 N Long 87-07 W.

Monday July 8th 1872
 Comes with light baffling air and
 calm - Ship between Whale point and Cape
 Dalton Land 8 mls distant. 5 AM in Boat
 toward for a whale. no chance to strike whale
 going quick N.E. Mid. and latter part
 strong breeze from N.W. and clear weather
 crossing between Cape Th. and Depot Island
 Lat 63-55 N Long 88-15 W.

Tuesday July 9th
 Comes with fresh breeze from W
 with passing clouds - Ship off Depot
 Island working to W. Mid. Middle
 part the weather Latter part strong
 breeze from the N.W. with detached
 clouds - heading S.S.W. by Comp. - Dist.
 from Cape Dalton in the sight
 Lat 63-48 N Long 90-54 W.

Wed July 10th
 Comes with light breeze from W
 with good weather Ship working
 to S.W. Middle part fresh at W
 latter fresh breeze from S.W. and
 good weather employed making spinn-
 yam, Carpenter repairing W Boat
 Lat At 4 AM sighted Marble
 Island 12 mls distant. D.M. steered
 to the N.E. under all sail
