

Refuels Bay Aug 23rd 72
This day begins with a fresh S.E.
gale with rain Middle and latter
strong gale from S. and cloudy Bay
and Harbor full of ice. Ship riding
at both anchors

Saturday Aug 24th
The gale continues strong from S.
with thick weather with rain. Ship
riding with both anchors. The ice has
has come against us and dragged both
anchors - Ship is trailing out the West
passage - but near the shore on the Port
Quarter -

Sunday Aug 25th
Comes with a strong gale at S.W.
with thick and rainy weather. Middle
and latter parts. Fresh breeze from
S. and cloudy. Ship riding with
both anchors, closely beset with ice

Monday Aug 26th
Comes with a light breeze from E.
and thick rainy weather. S. & M. calm.
Here up the anchors and towed ship
away from the shore. Dropped anchor
again on 19 fathoms - Latter part light
air - air and calm - Bay still full of ice

Tuesday Aug 27th 1872
Calm and light breeze from Eastward
with thick fog and rain. Ice in
still blocked with ice - Some of the
returned from Deer hunting brought about
some meat

Wed Aug 28th
Light air from S.E. and thick
cloudy weather. M. still remain blocked
in with ice so we cannot leave a boat

Thursday Aug 29th
There is no change in the wind or
weather, it still remains at S. and
S.E. and the ice still closely beset
us

Friday Aug 30th
This day has been calm and cloudy
with no change in the ice

Saturday Aug 31st
Comes calm and pleasant wind
and latter parts light and variable
air from S. and E. with cloudy
weather. The ice remains the same

Sunday Sept 1st
Comes calm and pleasant latter
fresh breeze from N.W. with passing
clouds - The ice has started out
of the Harbor a little
