

Repulse Bay Sep 11th 1892

This day begins with calm and clear weather - Middle and Latter parts light breeze from S.W. and pleasant weather. Got off from the shore 25 lbs of fresh water - it is the first time since the 18th of Aug that we could get in to the watering place for ice.

Thursday Sept 12th

These 24 hours we have had a fresh gale from S.W. and clear weather. The ice has set out from the Harbor about 4 mls.

Friday Sept 13th

Cornes - with a fresh S.W. wind and pleasant weather - Boats went cruising to day - saw no whales. Middle part light S.W. breeze and calm. Latter part light breeze from S.E. and hazy weather.

Saturday Sept 14th

Cornes - with a fresh breeze from S.E. with thick weather - Boats went off this morning - 9 A.M. commencing to blow heavy from S. with hail snow and rain. Boats returned to shore at noon - ice coming fast - Latter part gale more moderate but rain continues - Bay full of ice.

Sunday Sept 15th 1892

Cornes - with a strong wind from S.E. thick weather with rain - Middle part strong breeze from S. and cloudy. Latter part strong breeze from S.W. with passing clouds - Harbor blocked with ice.

Monday Sept 16th

This day we have had a fresh breeze from S.E. with fog and rainy weather - We are blocked in with ice as usual - Broke out a cask of bread and pork.

Tuesday Sept 17th

Cornes - with a light S.E. wind with thick weather and drizzling rain. Middle and Latter part light air from S.W. and pleasant weather. The Harbor blocked with ice.

Wed. Sept 18th

This begins calm and pleasant - Middle part light and variable breeze and pleasant - Latter part fresh breeze from S.E. and cloudy. No change with ice.

Thursday Sept 19th

First part light and variable breeze and cloudy. Middle and Latter part fresh breeze from S.W. to W. the ice is starting out a little - Dredged the Port anchor and got ready to get underway.
