

Saturday Sept 28th 1874
This day we have had light air from
E & N. and pleasant weather.
Boats went off this morning. Retained
at noon having seen no whales. The
pack is in sight to eastward but
towards Beachy Point it scattering
from most head.

Sunday Sept 29th
First part light air from E
and cloudy. Middle part calm
and pleasant. Latter part light
air from N. and cloudy. Boats
off cruising until noon. P.M. broke
out water from the hold.

Monday Sept 30th
There 24 hours we have had calm
and light air from N.E. with
thick cloudy weather and snow.

Tuesday Oct 1st
First and middle parts calm and
thick weather with snow. Latter
part calm and pleasant. The
pack has changed but little last
few days. There is a little water
around the station.

Wednesday Oct 2nd
This day we have had light air from
N.E. and calm with thick cloudy
weather with light snow squalls.

Thursday Oct 3rd
Calm with light air from N.E. and
cloudy. Middle part fresh breeze from
the same quarter. Latter part light
breeze from N. and cloudy. Boats
cruised between the Island and north
shore where there is a little water but
no whales.

Friday Oct 4th
Calm with a fresh breeze from
N. and cloudy. Middle and latter
parts fresh breeze from N. and
clear weather. Boats off cruising.
The pack is beginning to freeze
together. Broke out molasses.

Saturday Oct 5th
Calm with light breeze from N.
and clear weather. Middle part
fresh breeze from N. to N.W.
with passing clouds. Boats off
cruising. The pack has set off
a few miles. Tonight 12 Pelicans flying.
