

10-15 Reports Bay Tuesday Oct 17th
10-A To day we have had fresh breeze
from N - and cloudy weather
Employed hooking out provisions
and coal and stowing the Hides
Ship is firmly frozen in a little
water in sight to Southward

10-19 Wednesday Oct 18th
10-A Strong breeze from N. and
clear weather. Employed putting
casks on shore and cutting through
water ice - the ice is 10 inches
thick

10-20 Thursday Oct 19th
10-A Comes with a strong wind from
N. with clear weather. Mid-
and latter part - wind moderated
Put the Galley between deck and
put some empty casks on shore

10-21 Wednesday Oct 19th
10-A To day we have had light and
variable air and pleasant
weather. - Put three Boats ashore
and housed in the quarter deck

10-22 Saturday Oct 19th
10-A Comes - calm and pleasant mid-
and latter part fresh breeze from
S. and cloudy - Blacksmith
to work at the forge

Winters Quarters 1872
Sunday Oct 20th
10-A These 24 hours we have had a strong
gale from S.E. with snow. Latter
part gale moderated

Monday Oct 21st
10-A The gale continues strong from S.E.
with thick snowy weather. Got a load
of ice from the shore Blacksmith
repairing shovels &c

10-22 Thursday Oct 22nd
10-A Moderate gale from East with
thick and snow. Blacksmith at
the forge

10-23 Wednesday Oct 23rd
10-A Comes with a fresh breeze from
N.W. and clear weather. Middle
and latter part light air from
the same quarter with thick hazy
weather.

10-24 Thursday Oct 24th
10-A Comes with strong breeze from
E. with thick weather and snow.
Latter light breeze from N. and cloudy

10-25 Friday Oct 25th
10-A Fresh breeze from N.W. and
and clear weather. Latter part
moderate from same quarter
