6-A. First part light air from S.W.
 Latter part light variable air and
 calm pleasant weather. Employed
 hauling snow from the shore

Tuesday Nov 5th

21-A. Light breeze from S. to S.E.
 with cloudy weather and a light
 fall of snow. Started work of coal

Wednesday Nov 6th

24-A. Light air from S.W. with thick
 snowy weather. All our men
 that went to the natives returned
 to ship tonight with several natives

Thursday Nov 7th

16-A. Light air from N.W. with thick
 hazy weather. Latter part fresh breeze
 at 11 AM and clear weather

Friday Nov 8th

4-B. Light air from N.W. with
 calm and clear weather. Hauled
 off a load of ice.
 Three men have the scurvy

Winter Quarters 1892

Saturday Nov 9th

11-B. This day we have a strong wind
 from N. with clear weather.
 Mr. Miller and Stenon one of the
 who has scurvy went inland with
 the natives

Sunday Nov 10th

12-B. First part fresh wind from N.W.
 and clear weather. Latter calm
 and hazy. The man Stephen
 returned onboard last night

Monday Nov 11

12-A. Light air from N.W. with clear
 and pleasant weather. Employed
 hauling snow from the shore
 Building an eagle and banking the
 flat-tops

Tuesday Nov 12th

12-B. This day we have a strong wind
 from N.W. with clear weather

Wed - Nov 13th

12-B. Calm with a light breeze
 from N.W. with pleasant weather
 Latter part fresh breeze from
 S.W. with snow. Mr. Miller
 returned onboard
