Thursday Nov 14th

This day we have had a strong gale from N W with clear and pleasant weather.

Friday Nov 15th

2 A.

First part of this light from N with thick frosty weather. Latter part fresh breeze from W with clear weather. Peter and Carpenter went inland to the natives.

Saturday Nov 16th

4-10 B.

This day we have had a strong gale from N W. The air thick with frost.

Sunday Nov 17th

6-B.

Fresh gale from N W with thick hazy weather. Two natives arrived on board.

Monday Nov 18th

4-B.

This day we have a fresh gale from N W with hazy sky. Carpenter and Peter returned to ship.

Tuesday Nov 19th

2 1/2-B.

First part calm and pleasant. Latter part fresh breeze from N. A number of natives arrived.

Winter Quarters

1842

Wednesday Nov 20

3-4

Light variable wind from N to N E and calm. First part cloudy. Latter part clear. Natives brought about 200 lbs Deer meat. Wolves killed two dogs near the ship last night.

Thursday Nov 21st

13-B.

This day we have had light wind from N W and calm with hazy weather. The water is about 4 Mls off.

Friday Nov 22^d

12-B.

Calm and pleasant weather. A native sled arrived with some Deer meat.

Saturday Nov 23rd

16-B.

First calm and pleasant. Latter part fresh breeze from N. The Wolves made an attack on the dogs this morning and wounded two.

Sunday Nov 24th

4-B.

First part fresh breeze from S E and cloudy with light snow. Latter part calm and cloudy.
