1972

Temperatures -

Monday Nov 25

14-B- These 24 hours we have had light air N. and calm pleasant weather - Several natives left the ship and another family arrived.

Tuesday Nov 26<sup>th</sup>

6-B- These 24 hours we have had light air from N. & a calm. The Bay is frozen over as far as we can see.

Wednesday Nov 27<sup>th</sup>

13-B- These 24 hours calm and pleasant weather.

Thursday Nov 28

25-B- First part calm and pleasant. Middle part fresh breeze at N. Latter part calm - Mr. Barry and Spencer went inland with the natives.

Friday Nov 29

10-B- All this day we have had calm and pleasant weather - No water in sight from the hills - There are now 7 or 8 families of natives living around the ship.

## Winter Harbour.

1972

Saturday Nov 30<sup>th</sup>

1-B- First part light air from N. and fine weather. Latter part calm and hazy weather.

Sunday Dec 1<sup>st</sup>

1-B- All of this day we have had light air from N. and calm pleasant weather.

Monday Dec 2<sup>nd</sup>

1-B- These 24 hours we have had a strong gale from N. and the air thick with drifting snow. Mr. Barry and Spencer returned on board. Also five or six more families of natives arrived.

Tuesday Dec 3<sup>rd</sup>

1-B- Comes with a heavy gale from N. the air thick with drifting snow. Latter part more moderate.

Wednesday Dec 4<sup>th</sup>

1-B- The gale continues strong from N. with thick cloudy weather.

Thursday Dec 5<sup>th</sup>

2-B- Comes with a fresh gale from N. and cloudy - Latter part much the same - Water 2 mls off. Hauls ice.
