Temple of air

Friday Dec 6th

12-B- This day we have had light air from N.W. and cloudy - Employed banking ship

Saturday Dec 7th

12-B- Corner - light air from N.W. and pleasant weather - Latter part calm and clear - Finished banking ship

Sunday Dec 8th

12-B- Calm and fine weather - Breeze about 2 knots

Monday Dec 9th

12-B- First part strong breeze from N.W. and clear - Latter part light air from the same quarter and pleasant

Tuesday Dec 10th

27-B- First part strong wind from N.W. and clear weather - Latter part calm and pleasant

Wednesday Dec 11th

30-B- Calm and hazy weather - The Bay frozen over again

Winter Quarters Dec 1892

Thursday Dec 12th

4-B- Light air from N.W. and hazy weather - Latter part calm and air thick with frost - Capt Potter and Albat started for the Head of the Bay with dog team

Friday Dec 13th

4-B- Strong gale from N.E. the air thick with drifting snow

Saturday Dec 14th

12-B- Corner with a light air from N.E. and clear weather - Latter part fresh wind from the same quarter and cloudy

Sunday Dec 15th

15-B- Corner with light air from N.W. - Latter part calm and pleasant - Capt P. returned on board last night - Left part of his load - Mr. Miller and two natives started this morning to get what was left

Monday Dec 16th

37-B- Corner - calm and clear weather - Latter part light air from N.W. and clear - Mr. Miller returned at 4 P.M. with about 500 lbs of meat
