

Repulse Bay Dec 1872

Receipts of air

Saturday Dec 28th

13-B This day we have had light breeze from N.W. with clear and pleasant weather. A few of the natives of this tribe have gone down a sealing and several more have arrived from other tribes. They most all are short of food and many are suffering for want of it.

Sunday Dec 29th

22-B This day comes with a fresh breeze from N.W. and clear latter part calm and pleasant.

Monday Dec 30th

24-B Light air from S.W. and pleasant weather.

Tuesday Dec 31st

4-B Comes with a fresh breeze from S.E. and thick with a light fall of snow. Dried and latter part calm and thick. Several Puller Bay natives arrived here.

Winter Quarters Jan 1st 1873

Receipts of air

Wednesday

24-B This day we have a strong gale from N.W. with thick smoky weather. In the evening the men performed as minstrels.

Thursday Jan 2nd

10-B Fresh wind from N. with thick foggy weather.

Friday Jan 3rd

40-B This day has been calm and clear foggy weather. Albatross mother the oldest squaw in the tribe died last night.

Saturday Jan 4th

39-B This day begins with a light air from E. and pleasant ends with calm and pleasant weather.

Sunday Jan 5th

4-B This day we have had a strong breeze from S.W. with clear and pleasant weather.

Tuesday Jan 6th

25-B This day has been calm and clear pleasant weather. Several natives of the Mchilly tribe arrived here to day. Bought about 2 pounds lbs of Deer meat of them.
