Wednesday Jan 7th

35-B- Light air from Southward and
fine weather. Two wolves came
near the ship to day. Three families
started for Beachy point a sealing

Thursday Jan 8th

36-B- Light wind from NW with clear
pleasant weather. Hauled up a
load of ice

Friday Jan 9th

42-B- This day has been calm and
pleasant. Started to work of Bread

Saturday Jan 10th

41-B- First calm and clear. Latter
part fresh breeze from NW and
clear weather

Sunday Jan 11th

44-B- This day we have had a strong gale
from NW with clear weather.
Commenced using the coal for the
After Hold. Broke the cook and
sent him forward for stealing
provisions. Henry was acting
deceit

Winter Harbour 1873

Summary of air

Sunday Jan 12th

45-B- This day began calm and pleasant.
Latter part strong gale from SE
and hazy

Monday Jan 13th

46-B- Comes with a strong gale
at SE. Middle part SE. Latter
part strong gale from SE with
clear sky

Tuesday Jan 14th

48-B- Comes with a moderate wind from
NW. Latter part strong gale from
NW and clear weather. Hauled
a load of ice from the point

Wednesday Jan 15th

48-B- This day we have had a strong
gale from NW with clear weather

Thursday Jan 16th

38-43-B- This day we had had strong
squalls from NW to NW with
with frost smoke

Friday Jan 17th

52-B- This day began with strong wind
from NW and clear. Middle
and latter parts light wind
from the same quarter and
pleasant
