Saturday Jan 18th

46-B- This day begins calm and pleasant. Latter part strong wind from N and clear weather. Dred out oil about 10 gallons to the natives. Served out flour. Meat in molla.

Sunday Jan 19th

46-B- This day begins with light variable winds and pleasant. Wind - and Latter part calm and pleasant.

Monday Jan 20th

42-B- This day begins with a fresh breeze from N. and clear weather. Latter part calm and pleasant.

Tuesday Jan 21st

40-B- This day has been calm and pleasant. Most of the natives have their huts around the ship.

Wednesday Jan 22nd

30-B- Comes with a light breeze from N. and cloudy. Latter part calm and pleasant.

Thursday Jan 23rd

36-B- Strong wind from N. W. with thick hazy weather.

Winter Quarters 1873

Friday Jan 24th

42-B- This day begins with a light breeze from N. W. and fine weather. Latter part calm and pleasant.

Saturday Jan 25th

44-B- This day begins calm and thick. Latter part light air from E. and hazy weather. The natives that went to Beachy Point a sealing have returned unsuccessful.

Sunday Jan 26th

44-B- This day begins with a fresh wind from N. N. E. and cloudy. Latter part part strong breeze at N. and clear weather.

Monday Jan 27th

52-B- This day begins calm with clear weather. Latter strong gale from S. W. and clear. Sky. Capt. Potter started on a fishing expedition.

Tuesday Jan 28th

40-B- This day has been calm and hazy. One of natives that went with the Capt. came back with the dog team.
